Church Council Meeting - 14th December 1944

Extract

A letter was read from Mr Scougal, the Secretary of the Church circle, asking for permission to purchase two keys for the Church hall, one for himself, the other for the Sunday School Superintendent, as they were having difficulty in getting access to the church and the hall. The Council were of the opinion that the applicants or anyone else seeking admission to the Church premises should have no difficulty if they apply to the hall-letting secretary. They declined to grant permission to obtain two keys as they felt that no organisations should have keys.
