

Special Church Council Meeting - 30th April 1944

Extract

The Pastor intimated that the G.A. were entertaining the wounded soldiers to tea in the Church hall, and the leader of this organisation asked the Council if they would lift the no smoking ban for this particular occasion. While not forgetting the good work this organisation is doing, and appreciating the gesture on the girls part, the Council felt they could not relax the no smoking restriction. After the discussion it was moved and seconded that the ban remain. This was agreed to.
